## <u>Sub:-Intimation Regarding Extension of Time to hold Annual General Meeting for the Financial Year Ended on 31st March, 2020.</u>

Dear Sir/Madam,

With reference to the captioned subject, we would like to inform you that in accordance with the provisions of Section 96 of the Companies Act, 2013, the Company was required to convene its AGM with 6 months from the end of financial year i.e. till 30th September, 2020. However Registrar of Companies (ROC), Mumbai of Maharashtra vide its order dated 8th September, 2020 which was published on the website of MCA on 10<sup>th</sup> September, 2020, have given a general extension to all the Companies within its jurisdiction, which are unable to hold Annual General Meeting for the Financial Year ended on 31st March, 2020 due to difficulties faced in view of COVID-19 pandemic, by a period of three months from the due date by which the AGM ought to have been held in accordance with the provisions of sub-section (1) of section 96 of the Companies Act, 2013. The copy of general order of ROC is enclosed herewith for your ready reference.

Accordingly, the Company will convene its Annual General Meeting for the Financial Year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2020, within the extended timeline provided by ROC and date of AGM shall be intimated to your good office within due course of time.

Kindly consider this information as relevant disclosure under the provisions of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015.

## Order: Extension of time for holding of Annual General Meeting (AGM) for the Financial Year ended on 31.03.2020

- 1. Whereas sub-section (1) of section 96 of the Companies Act. 2013 (the Act) provides, inter-atia, that every company, other than a One Person Company, shall in each year hold in addition to any other meetings, a general meeting as its general meeting (AGM) and shall specify the meeting as such in the notices calling it, and not more than affect months shall obopse between the date of one AGM of a company and that of the next;
- 2. And whereas, the first provise to sub-section (1) of section 96 of the Act provides that in case of the first AGM, it shall be held within a period of nine mentils from the date of closing of the first financial year of the company and in any other case, within a period of six months. From the date of closing of the financial year:
- 3. And whereas, the third provise to section 96(1) of the Act provides that the Registrar may, for any special reason, extend the time within which any annual general meeting, other than the first annual general supering, shall be held, by a period not exceeding three months:
- 4. And whereas, various representations have been received from the companies. Industry bodies and Professional Institutes pointing out that several companies are finding it difficult to hold their AGM for the financial year ended on 3 (103.2020 due to the difficulties faced in view of the Covid -19 Pandenvic;
- 5. And whereus, the representations have been considered and the undersigned is of the considered opinion that due to such unprecedented special reasons, the time within which the AGM for the financial year ended on 31.03.2020 is

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required to be held as per provisions of sub-section (1) of section 96 aught to be extended in terms of the third provise to section 96(1):

6. Now, therefore, in terms of power vested with the undersigned under the third proviso to sub-section (1) of section 96 of the Act, I hereby extend the time to hold the AGM, other than the first AGM, for the financial year ended on 31-03.2020 for companies within the jurisdiction of this office, which are unable to hold their AGM for such period within the due date of holding the AGM by a period of three months from the due date by which the AGM ought to have been held in accordance with the provisions of sub-section (1) of section 96 of the Act, without requiring the companies to file applications for seeking such extension by filing the prescribed Form No. GNL-1.

<u>Explanation</u>: It is hereby clarified that the extension granted under this Order shall also gover the:

- (i) pending applications filed in form not gal-it for the extension of AGM for the tinancial year ended on 31.03.2020, which are yet to be approved;
- (ii) applications filed in Form No. GNL -1 for the extension of AGM for the financial year ended on 31.03,2020, which were rejected,

Where the approval for extension of AGM up to 3 months from the due date of the AGM shall be deemed to have been granted by the undersigned without any further action on the part of the company.
