THE MODALITIES OF UTILIZATION OF FUNDS AND IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULES FOR THE PROJECTS OR PROGRAMMES

- > The Company shall disburse the Funds to the Implementing agencies before the start of the project based on the Projection Report received from the Implementing agencies.
- > The Funds disbursed by the Company shall be tentatively spent by the Implementing Agency towards the relevant project (s) within 60 to 120 days of disbursement.
- > The Company shall ensure that administrative overheads shall not exceed 5% of the total CSR expenditure of the Company for the financial year. Further, these expenses would not include expenses incurred by the Company towards designing, implementation, monitoring, and evaluation.

THE IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULES WITH RESPECT TO CSR PROJECTS

- > The Company shall disburse the Funds as per the projections received from the Implementing agency.
- > The Funds disbursed shall be applied by the Implementing Agency toward the specific Project till the time the project is completed.
- > The Projects undertaken by the Implementing Agency are generally for a tenure of 1 year, however, if the same is carried forward further, the Board shall take note of the same and treat it as an ongoing project at a later stage by making necessary amendments in Annual Action Plan.

MONITORING AND REPORTING MECHANISM

- > Monitoring of CSR activities and Assessment of utilization of funds will be done by the Board of Directors of the Company on a periodical basis along with the filing of an annual consolidated utilization annexure which will form part of the Company's Annual Report.
- > The company shall be authorizing the Company Secretary of the Company to verify the spending, monitor the projects, and visit the site wherein the projects are undertaken on a sample basis.
- > The Implementing Agency shall provide certificates under Section 80G of the Income Tax Act. 1961, and utilization certificates at the completion of the project or March 31 of every year for the fund disbursed during that financial year.
- > The Implementing Agency shall provide the receipts for the funds received by the Company and it shall provide necessary proofs as and when required by the Company for Inspection.

DETAILS OF NEED AND IMPACT ASSESSMENT, IF ANY

As Company's average CSR obligation does not exceed Rupees 10 Crore in the three immediately preceding financial years hence, the Company is not required to conduct an impact assessment through an independent agency as per the provisions of the Act.
